Background:	Supportive services, as defined in WIOA section 134(3)(2), are allowable for DWG participants employed in the grant. The use of DWG funds for supportive services is subject to the requirements delineated in WIOA and the implementing regulations.
Policy:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The maximum for dislocated worker support services is \$280 per month. This amount may be reduced if WIOA Fiscal determines that funds are insufficient. 2. Support payments will be made directly to participants upon verification that the participant is actively working in the grant. Time sheets or other verification must be submitted to WIOA staff to be paid by WIOA Fiscal. 3. Dislocated workers may receive additional work-related support for uniforms, shoes or supplies necessary for employment when they are employed. The employer must state that the items are necessary for the employee. 4. Child care support will be provided, if noted as a barrier to employment, on the Individual Employment Plan, to all eligible parenting dislocated workers, up to a maximum of \$90 per week (for one child) or \$135 per week (for two children) or \$180 per week (three plus maximum) with a time limit consistent with employment in the grant. <p>The Dean of Workforce Development may approve an exception to this policy. Exceptions to the policy must be documented in the participant case files.</p>
